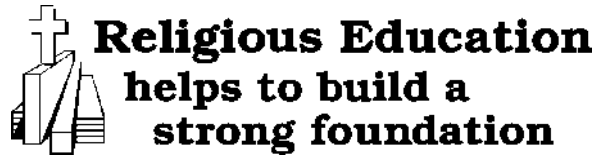

I want to ensure that families are aware of the new process for **Religious Education Registration** for the fall of 2010. Registration materials were mailed out during the first week of February.

Our parish is committed to quality in our religious education program. We partner with families to provide a rich experience of faith formation for all of our children. This partnership involves creating and sustaining practices that strengthen service to an increasing number of children and volunteer catechists.

On the recommendation of the Religious Education Advisory Board, the parish has a revised registration process for Fall 2010 enrollment. **This involves registration now. If your child is not registered before June 15, 2010, you may seek services at another parish, or pursue a home school option for the upcoming year.** Please note that home schooling is not an option for sacramental formation years in grades 2, 9 and 10.

Support our part time staff and volunteer catechists with your cooperation. **Register your child now.** If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me.
